

# Lancaster County Active Transportation Advisory Committee (ATAC)

## MEETING MINUTES

### ORDER OF BUSINESS:

1. **Call to Order** – The meeting was called to order at 7:04 PM. Mr. Bini read through the list of Committee members to confirm their attendance. He announced that Amy Spellman resigned from the Committee due to personal obligations. Staff will work on filling the Committee vacancy. The Committee will be updated about that process at the June meeting.
2. **Call to Audience** – None.
3. **Minutes of January 23, 2020 Meeting (Action)** – No discussion.

**Mr. Tobler made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, and seconded by Ms. Finn. It passed by a vote of 6-0 with Mr. Hoffman abstaining.**

4. **Review ATP Implementation** – Ms. Barr reviewed the discussion of ATP action items and interest expressed by Committee members at the January 23, 2020 meeting. This discussion is captured in the meeting minutes from that meeting. She asked for any updates on progress since then. None were noted.

Ms. Barr and Mr. Bini provided an update on ATP implementation funding. Staff worked with PennDOT District 8 to advance three projects – Rt. 324/Enola Low Grade Trail Crossing Safety Analysis, Route 30 Bike-Ped Crossing Study, and a Lancaster County Active Transportation Map. The Rt.324/Enola Low Grade Trail crossing safety analysis is a high priority project because recent improvements to the intersection for automobile and truck traffic have inadvertently created an unsafe at-grade crossing for trail users. These improvements were led by the Lancaster County Transportation Authority using MPO funding. Due to the severity of safety concerns, Martic Township has closed access to the trail at this location. The Route 30 Bike-Ped Crossing Study and Lancaster County Active Transportation Map were listed as implementation items in the ATP.

Ms. Barr reviewed each ATP implementation project. Mr. Bini provided additional context. Committee members indicated their interest in projects for periodic review and input:

5. **Updates on ATAC Resurfacing Recommendations** – Ms. Barr stated there are no updates on the resurfacing recommendations from the January 23, 2020 meeting. They were submitted to the PennDOT project manager. Due to COVID-19, many projects are paused, and staff are hard to reach. LCPC staff will wait until it is a less chaotic and uncertain environment to follow-up with the project managers.
6. **Other Business & Public Participation** – Mr. Bini provided an update on the development of the Lancaster MPO’s Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP), connects2040. He and Ms. Barr noted the MTP’s policy areas and recommendations are supportive of multimodal transportation. He encouraged Committee members to review the draft plan available on the MPO website. Staff anticipate the MTP to be adopted at the June 22<sup>nd</sup> MPO meeting.
