Project Description

Quarryville Elementary Student Senate consists of 10 fifth grade students who were selected to join the group through an application process. This year, the Student Senate decided to plan a large-scale project for the 2021-2022 school year to improve their school and/or community. After reviewing several project ideas, Senators voted and decided to plan and implement a collection of donated items for the Humane League of Lancaster County. Senators wrote proposals to our principal, created advertisements, designed collection bins to place around the school, and prepared donations for drop off at the Humane League. The group nominated and elected a Student Senate Historian who was charged with documenting this and other group projects. After the completion of the collection, senators reflected on what went well and changes they would make for future efforts.

Supporting Materials

Senators compiled a list of possible project ideas. They voted and determined that their top two ideas were to organize a collection for an animal shelter and create a "New Student" guide for our town.

- ① Help Out an Animal Shelter - Organize a collection of items to donate to an animal shelter.
2. Make Valentine's for Senior Citizens.
3. Decorate placemats for Meals on Wheels.
4. Make a no-sew fleece blanket for a child in need through Project Linus.
- ⑤ Make a "New Student" guide to your town that includes your favorite parks, a map of the neighborhood, and fun things to do.
6. Plant a garden or tree that your school or neighborhood can enjoy.
7. Volunteer to wash trucks at the Qville Fire Department
8. Clean up trash in the community, park, or at school

Senators developed proposals for both projects to for submission to our building principal, Rebecca Gajecki. Students started by creating a rough draft of their proposal and then, completed a final copy for submission. Mrs. Gajecki reviewed both proposals and approved both projects. Senators then decided to start with the animal shelter collection.





Supporting Materials Cont.


