Introduction

Lancaster County MPO partners with PennDOT to implement the Local Technical Assistance Program (LTAP) throughout Lancaster County. LTAP provides transportation-related training opportunities to municipalities to assist them with their local transportation needs.

Program Overview

The 2024-2025 fiscal year is the 14th year that the Lancaster County MPO has partnered with PennDOT to offer LTAP services to the 60 municipalities in Lancaster County. The courses and tech assists provided by LTAP trainers and technical experts provide valuable training and assistance to municipal staff.

Program Highlights

LTAP Survey

- Emailed municipal survey (Attachment A) on February 7, 2025, to roadmasters and public works directors at all 60 municipalities in Lancaster County.
- Five municipalities returned the survey between February and April, for a response rate of 8%.
- Survey results (Attachment B) included municipal data and course interest indicated by municipalities.

LTAP Courses

- Between July 1, 2024, and June 30, 2025, Lancaster County MPO scheduled four LTAP courses
- Of the four classes, three were held and one class was cancelled due to low enrollment
- For the three courses held, 58 people registered and 49 people attended. This is an average of 16.3 attendees per course

- LTAP emails were forwarded to relevant email lists and to relevant planning staff so that they could encourage municipal staff in their planning areas to register as appropriate.
